

Notice of Hospital Rate Increase for Reedsburg Area Medical Center

Reedsburg Area Medical Center, located at 2000 N Dewey Avenue, Reedsburg, Wisconsin 53959, has a fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2021. Effective November 1, 2020, this hospital will implement a price increase to patient charges of 2% over current charges. The date of the last price increase for this hospital was November 1, 2019 when a 3% increase was implemented.
