

Notice of Hospital Rate Increase for Reedsburg Area Medical Center

Reedsburg Area Medical Center, located at 2000 N Dewey Avenue, Reedsburg, Wisconsin 53959, has a fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and ending September 30, 2022. There will be no price increase this fiscal year. The date of the last price increase for this hospital was November 1, 2020 when a 2% increase was implemented.
